He has a military background and very much enjoys getting out into the community, as well as taking part in social and leisure pursuits such as cycling and attending the local gyms and swimming pools. He enjoys social participation and talking to people. Due to his brain injury, he requires support with all aspects of daily living, including preparation of meals, domestic tasks and his engagement in social & leisure interests. Still, he has a great determination to be as independent as possible. Assistance with the client's mobility rehabilitation is essential to the role. Following his brain injury, his limitations are predominately physical, and these are constantly improving. He is a highly driven, upbeat and positive person with a great sense of humour and appreciative of his team.

Support requirements:

To maximise our client's independence.

To work closely with the client's rehabilitation team, including a physiotherapist and speech and language therapist.

We are looking for someone who is dynamic, self-motivated, and enthusiastic. They should be able to work independently with the client and be good team players.

Must hold a full driver's licence.
